Uniform Requirements



YEARS K-5

Junior School uniforms are available for purchase at the Uniform Shop at Curacoa Street. Shop hours are Tues & Wed 8.30am - 9.30am during school terms. The shop operates in January on selected dates by appointment only please telephone the Accounts Office on 6653 4000 to make an appointment.

BOYS - Junior School: Years K- 5

<u>SHIRT</u>: Unisex polo shirt with school logo.

<u>SHORTS</u>: Navy shorts with school logo.

<u>JUMPER:</u> Red fleece with school logo AND/OR

JACKET: Water resistant with school logo.

TRACK PANTS:

(Optional) Navy pants with school logo (Worn Terms 2 & 3).

SOCKS: White with double blue stripe.

<u>HAT:</u> Slouch Hat or Cap with school logo (No hat no play policy).

GIRLS - Junior School: Years K- 5

<u>SHIRT:</u> Unisex polo shirt with school logo.

SHORTS: Navy shorts with school logo OR

SKORT: Navy skort with school logo.

<u>JUMPER:</u> Red fleece with school logo AND/OR

<u>JACKET:</u> Water resistant with school logo.

TRACK PANTS: (Optional) Navy pants with school logo (Worn Terms 2 & 3).

SOCKS: White with CHCCS letters.

<u>HAT:</u> Slouch Hat or Cap with school logo (No hat no play policy).

<u>RAINCOATS:</u> Compulsory for each child. Can be purchased from the school uniform shop or parents can provide.

<u>HAIR:</u> Shoulder length hair must be tied back and not cover eyes. An elastic, ribbon or hair band may be worn in plain white, blue or red, no wider than 4cm. Hair styles must not 'make a statement' i.e. set the student apart significantly from other students (this includes mullets and mohawks). Dyed hair must only be in 'natural' hair colours.

<u>JEWELLERY:</u> Simple studs or regular sleepers for pierced ears (silver, gold or small stones permitted); maximum two per ear. Smart watches are not permitted. Medical Alerts and Symbolic arm bands with the approval of the Principal may be worn. No other jewellery or piercings are permitted.

NAIL POLISH AND MAKEUP: Is not permitted.

REFUND / EXCHANGE POLICY

CHCCS will refund (for store credit) or exchange uniform products subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Items must be returned within 21 days of purchase with the original receipt.
- 2. The returned items must be unworn, unwashed, unused with original tags/labels attached.
- 3. Every effort is made to order quality articles of uniform and the school should not be held responsible for manufacturer defects. If the item appears faulty the school may choose to forward the items to the supplier for further assessment and determination on repair or replacement.
- 4. Health regulations prevent hats and socks being exchanged or refunded after purchase.
- 5. There is no replacement, exchange or refund for second hand items (limited stock available)
- 6. The school does not refund / exchange due to change of mind.

NB: CASH refunds are not available.

IMPORTANT ADDITONAL INFORMATION

<u>PARENTAL NOTE:</u> Is required if your child wears a nonuniform item for the day. The note must be signed and dated. Your child is to report to the front office upon arrival at school to present their note or hand it to their class teacher.

UNIFORM MODIFICATION: Is not permitted.

SHOES: All school shoes must be ALL BLACK, FULLY ENCLOSED, POLISHABLE LACE UP, VELCRO or BUCKLE style shoes. Preferably leather. Canvas shoes and boots are not permitted.


SIZING

The school uniform must fit students correctly and in a standard manner. School students naturally grow and there will be times when students will need to purchase new uniforms. School uniforms must meet the following sizing requirements:

<u>SHIRTS:</u> The hemline of the shirt should be no shorter than touching the top thumb knuckle when the student's arms are held straight down beside the body.

<u>SKIRT and SHORTS:</u> The hemline should be no shorter than touching the top of the knee. The entire thigh should be covered.

<u>GIRLS SPORT SHORTS:</u> The hemline should be no shorter than 5cm above the knee.

MUFTI AND JEANS FOR GENES DAYS

MUFTI DAYS/SCHOOL SOCIALS

Students may attend school on Mufti Days in 'mufti'; i.e. non-school uniform. Mufti Days are fun and raise money for various charities. A gold coin donation is required for all students who choose to wear 'mufti'.

Students are expected to wear clothes that are sensible, modest and according to the following guidelines. Students who do not follow these guidelines for appropriate mufti day dress will be issued three (3) detentions. Students who dress in immodest clothing will be required to get changed into clothing provided by the school or spend the day in Time-out.

The following are NOT to be worn:

- Singlets of any kind and/or sleeveless T-shirts.
- Inappropriate logos/messages on T-shirts.
- Immodest tops or midriffs. Tops should not reveal your waist.
- Tight clothing.
- Short skirts & short shorts (i.e. must be at least ³/₄ of thiah).
- Pants, shorts and skirts should not have any rips or tears above the knee.
- Thongs/sandals (students <u>MUST</u> wear closed-inshoes). 'Van' style shoes are OK.
- <u>NO</u> facial piercings apart from our normal earpiercing rule (normal school rules apply re: jewellery).
- Years 9 -12 female students ONLY may wear SUBTLE makeup. OK: soft/lightly applied tinted moisturiser; blush; mascara – which is NOT thick and/or clumpy; lip gloss, (no lipstick).
- Hair does not have to be tied back UNLESS requested to do so by a class teacher <u>for that</u> <u>particular lesson</u>. (However, hair should not cover the face).
- Students are to wear either entirely mufti dress or full normal school uniform. A combination of both is not permitted. This includes school rules regarding hair tied up, makeup and jewellery.

JEANS FOR GENES DAY

Jeans for Genes is a fundraising campaign of Children's Medical Research Institute. A gold coin donation is required for all who are wearing jeans for the day.

Students are permitted to wear Jeans on the day with their normal school uniform tops. Please note: jeans should not have any rips or tears above the knee. In keeping with the spirit of the day, no denim shorts or skirts are permitted, only jeans.
