SPORTS UNIFORM YEARS 6-11 BOYS & GIRLS

Middle School Sports Day WEDNESDAY & Senior Sports Day FRIDAY

Sports uniform to be worn to school on sports day only and may be brought to school and changed into for PE class.

SHIRT: Unisex polo shirt with school logo.

<u>SPORT SHORTS:</u> Unisex four-way stretch cotton lined navy shorts with school logo.

SOCKS: Same socks as worn with school uniform.

<u>SHOES:</u> Black lace up shoes to be worn to and from school, a suitable sports 'jogger' may be changed into just prior to sport or PE (only).

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS YEARS 6-12

<u>PARENTAL NOTE</u>: Is required if your child wears a non-uniform item for the day. The note is to be dated and signed.

UNIFORM MODIFICATION: Is not permitted.

<u>SHOES:</u> All school shoes must be ALL BLACK, FULLY ENCLOSED, POLISHABLE LACE UP shoes. Preferably leather.

Not permitted: boots, ballet style, slip-ons, zippered, velcrotabs, platform or high heels, ugg boots, thongs or sandals, shoes with any openings.

<u>FOOT INJURY</u>: The injured foot should be covered by a dark sock (a sandal or thong may be with the sock if needed) and the school uniform shoe should cover the non- injured foot.

<u>HAT</u>: School Cap with CHCCS embroidery or School Slouch Hat with school logo. Compulsory for Middle School Sport. (Beanies are not permitted). **HAIR**: Shoulder length hair must be tied back and not cover eyes. An elastic, ribbon or hair band may be worn in plain white, blue or red, no wider than 4cm. Hair styles must not 'make a statement' i.e. set the student apart significantly from other students (this includes mullets and mohawks). Dyed hair must only be in 'natural' hair colours. Hair should present a natural look.

JEWELLERY: Simple studs or regular sleepers for pierced ears (silver, gold or small stones permitted); maximum two per ear. Smart watches are not permitted. Medical Alerts and Symbolic arm bands with the approval of the Principal may be worn. No other jewellery or piercings are permitted.

<u>NAILS:</u> Should look natural, therefore no false nails and no coloured nail polish permitted (including white Eg: French Tips).

TATTOOS: Visible tattoos are not acceptable at CHCCS.

<u>UNDERSHIRTS:</u> Only all white (100%) and not protruding beyond any part of the shirt. Round neck collars that are just showing a small triangle from the V-neck of the collared shirt is acceptable.

MAKE UP: Is NOT permitted in Years 6-10.

For Years 11-12, subtle makeup that looks natural is permitted (light tinted moisturiser, mascara or lip gloss) eyeliner, eyeshadow and lipstick are not permitted. False eyelashes are not permitted.

REFUND / EXCHANGE POLICY

CHCCS will refund (for store credit) or exchange uniform products subject to the following conditions:

1. Items must be returned within 21 days of purchase with the original receipt.

2. The returned items must be unworn, unwashed, unused with original tags/ labels attached.

3. Every effort is made to order quality articles of uniform and the school should not be held responsible for manufacturer defects. If the item appears faulty, the school may choose to forward the items to the supplier for further assessment and determination on repair or replacement.

4. Health regulations prevent hats and socks being exchanged or refunded after purchase.

5. There is no replacement, exchange or refund for second hand items (limited stock available)

6. The school does not refund / exchange due to change of mind.

NB: CASH refunds are not available.

SIZING

The school uniform must fit students correctly and in a standard manner. School students naturally grow and there will be times when students will need to purchase new uniforms. School uniforms must meet the following sizing requirements:

SHIRTS: The hemline of the shirt should be no shorter than touching the top thumb knuckle when the student's arms are held straight down beside the body.

SKIRT and SHORTS: The hemline should be no shorter than touching the top of the knee. The entire thigh should be covered.

GIRLS SPORT SHORTS: The hemline should be no shorter than 5cm above the knee.

LONG PANTS: Pant legs must cover socks when standing.

MUFTI AND JEANS FOR GENES DAYS

MUFTI DAYS/SCHOOL SOCIALS

Students may attend school on Mufti Days in 'mufti'; i.e. non-school uniform. Mufti Days are fun and raise money for various charities. A gold coin donation is required for all students who choose to wear 'mufti'.

Students are expected to wear clothes that are sensible, modest and according to the following guidelines. Students who do not follow these guidelines for appropriate mufti day dress will be issued three (3) detentions. Students who dress in immodest clothing will be required to get changed into clothing provided by the school or spend the day in Time-out.

The following are NOT to be worn:

- Singlets of any kind and/or sleeveless T-shirts.
- Inappropriate logos/messages on T-shirts.
- Immodest tops or midriffs. Tops should not reveal your waist.
- Tight clothing.
- Short skirts & short shorts (i.e. must be at least ³/₄ of thigh).
- Pants, shorts and skirts should not have any rips or tears above the knee.
- Thongs/sandals (students <u>MUST</u> wear closed-inshoes). 'Van' style shoes are OK.
- <u>NO</u> facial piercings apart from our normal earpiercing rule
- Years 9 -12 female students ONLY may wear SUBTLE makeup. OK: soft/lightly applied tinted moisturiser; blush; mascara which is NOT thick and/or clumpy; lip gloss, (no lipstick).
- Hair does not have to be tied back UNLESS requested to do so by a class teacher <u>for that</u> <u>particular lesson</u>. (However, hair should not

cover the face).

• Students are to wear either entirely mufti dress or full normal school uniform. A combination of both is not permitted. This includes school rules regarding hair tied up, makeup and jewellery.

JEANS FOR GENES DAY

Jeans for Genes is a fundraising campaign of Children's Medical Research Institute. A gold coin donation is required for all who are wearing jeans for the day.

Students are permitted to wear Jeans on the day with their normal school uniform tops. Please note: jeans should not have any rips or tears above the knee. In keeping with the spirit of the day, no denim shorts or skirts are permitted, only jeans.
