Finish the Race

At the Mexico Olympics in 1968, Tanzanian runner John Akhwari fell hard to the ground early in the race. He dislocated his knee and severely hurt his shoulder. The 26-year-old was forced to walk for long stretches, and by the halfway mark of the 42 km race, he was well out of contention. 18 of the 75 runners who started the race would pull out. Night fell over the course, but Akhwari pushed on through the pain. The winner, Mamo Wolde, had finished one hour and fifteen minutes earlier. By the time Akhwari approached the stadium, the medals had been awarded and the other athletes had left, but he was determined to finish the race. As he limped through the final lap of the stadium, the remaining crowd caught on and began to cheer wildly. As he crossed the finish line, the noise was deafening.

A journalist later asked him why he didn't give up when he knew he had no chance of winning. Akhwari replied, "My country didn't send me 5,000 miles to start the race. They sent me 5,000 miles to finish the race."

To finish well like Akhwari, we need persistence and determination. We need the tenacity and the grit to push on through trials and difficulties without giving up. There are plenty of talented men and women who don't finish well. When the going gets tough, they walk away from the things that once gave them great joy.

When I get to the end of my life I want to be able to say to my King, in the words of Paul in 2 Timothy, "I have fought the good fight, I have won the race, I have kept the faith."
